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**Please ensure you read this information about our remote education provision for pupils who are at home for any period during lockdown.**

Due to a national lockdown announced on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January, it is a government requirement that all children who remain at home have access to a remote education.

### **What will be provided by Longlands?**

The remote education provision will be designed by Longlands teachers and will use a curriculum sequence that allows access to high-quality online resources and teaching videos. These will be linked to the school's curriculum and expectations and all pupils, whether they are in school or at home, will receive the same curriculum offer and activities.

All lessons will provide frequent, clear explanations of new content, delivered by a teacher through high quality pre-recorded videos. Teachers will plan a programme that is of equivalent length to the **core** teaching pupils would receive in school. The expectation is that children work through the tasks and any work that is written down must be of a high standard in terms of presentation, spelling, handwriting, grammar and number formation. Any mistakes should be crossed out with a single line through them. Parents and carers will oversee their children's work. Children will be required to upload their work to Seesaw daily so that teachers can monitor how well pupils are progressing through the curriculum. This will also enable teachers to address any issues, and where necessary, revise material to ensure our pupils develop secure understanding. Class teachers will be available on Seesaw to support children with their learning between 1 – 3:30pm.

### **How will children access remote learning?**

Children will access learning using [Seesaw](#) and/or via a link to your personal email account

[A Zoom meeting will be set up once a week for all classes to link up with their peers and teacher for a chat and any other questions that may arise around the learning.](#)

The class teacher will inform you of their weekly slot on zoom which will be at the same time each week. There will also be a document sent out to you next week detailing how Zoom works and the school protocols for its use.

**Links to all remote learning will be sent to your personal emails and your Seesaw account.**

**All pupils are expected to do at least three hours of learning in the core curriculum per day. See timetable below.**

You will receive an email containing the links to the day's learning no later than 8am on the day.

Below is the outline of the day's programme that is equivalent in length to the **core** teaching pupils would receive in school.

<b>Reception</b>	Phonics and Handwriting 30 minutes	Talking and reading 45 minutes	Mark making and writing 30 minutes	Counting and number 45 minutes	Daily independent reading using Bug Club 10 minutes	Story time from teachers 20 minutes
<b>Key Stage 1 (Year 1 -2)</b>	Phonics or Spelling 20 minutes	Individual daily reading 20 minutes – using Bug Club	Counting and number facts practice 20 minutes	Reading task 30 minutes including story time with a teacher	Writing, grammar or punctuation tasks 45 minutes	Maths 45 minutes
<b>Key Stage 2 (Year 3 -6)</b>	Phonics or Spelling 30 minutes	Individual daily reading 30 minutes – using Bug Club	Number facts practice 30 minutes	Reading task 30 minutes	Writing, grammar or punctuation tasks 1 hour	Maths 1 hour

Pupils that have an EHCP will have some individualised learning uploaded to ensure that the curriculum being taught addresses their current educational needs and supports their progress.

If you would like to access non-core subjects in the afternoon such as history, art, geography, science etc. you can access additional lessons through Oak National Academy. Each lesson is hour-long. It is all easy to use, there is no login or password, you can access our lessons on any device, and pupils only need materials they can find at home.
