Summer 1 - words that I am learning in class:

<b>Immense</b>	Extremely large.
<b>Response</b>	A reply or a reaction to something that someone does or says.
<b>Extraordinary</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Extremely good or special.</li><li>2. Very unusual or surprising.</li></ol>
<b>Elaborate</b>	Involving many carefully arranged parts or details; detailed and complicated.
<b>Instant</b>	A very short period of time.
<b>Peculiar</b>	Strange or unusual.
<b>Blossom</b>	The flowers that appear on a fruit tree.
<b>Mock</b>	To laugh at someone and try to make them feel foolish.
<b>Infer</b>	To conclude something from evidence and reasoning rather than from exactly what has been seen or read.
<b>Retrieve</b>	To find or extract information.
<b>Evidence</b>	An object or a piece of information that makes you believe that something is true or has really happened.
<b>Summarise</b>	To give the most important points about something.
<b>Essential</b>	Necessary – it must be done.
<b>Attempt</b>	An occasion when you try do something.
<b>Erupt</b>	When a volcano erupts, it throws out hot, melted rock (lava).
<b>Disaster</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A very bad accident or event that may hurt many people.</li><li>2. Something that is not at all successful.</li></ol>
<b>Threat</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. When you say that something bad will happen to someone if they do not do what you want.</li><li>2. Something that can harm someone or something.</li></ol>
<b>Vast</b>	Extremely large.
<b>Precious</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Rare and worth a lot of money.</li><li>2. Important to you, that you do not want to lose.</li></ol>
<b>Recent</b>	That happened only a short time ago.
