Immense	Extremely large.
Response	A reply or a reaction to something that someone does or says.
Extraordinary	 Extremely good or special. Very unusual or surprising.
Elaborate	Involving many carefully arranged parts or details; detailed and complicated.
Instant	A very short period of time.
Peculiar	Strange or unusual.
Blossom	The flowers that appear on a fruit tree.
Mock	To laugh at someone and try to make them feel foolish.
Infer	To conclude something from evidence and reasoning rather than from exactly what has been seen or read.
Retrieve	To find or extract information.
Evidence	An object or a piece of information that makes you believe that something is true or has really happened.
Summarise	To give the most important points about something.
Essential	Necessary – it must be done.
Attempt	An occasion when you try do something.
Erupt	When a volcano erupts, it throws out hot, melted rock (lava).
Disaster	 A very bad accident or event that may hurt many people. Something that is not at all successful.
Threat	 When you say that something bad will happen to someone if they do not do what you want. Something that can harm someone or something.
Vast	Extremely large.
Precious	 Rare and worth a lot of money. Important to you, that you do not want to lose.
Recent	That happened only a short time ago.
