<b>Convert (conversion)</b>	To change the form of something.
<b>Ambitious (ambition)</b>	Having the determination to succeed.
<b>Compare (comparison, comparatively)</b>	To notice similarities and differences.
<b>Common (commonly)</b>	Often found. Something that is shared.
<b>Classify (classification)</b>	To group according to shared characteristics.
<b>Summarise (summary)</b>	To give the main points.
<b>Evidence (evidently)</b>	Facts or information to prove something.
<b>Efficient (efficiently)</b>	Working in a way that does not waste effort.
<b>Vary (variation, variety)</b>	To change.
<b>Generalise (general, generalisation)</b>	To come to a broad rule.
<b>Justify (justification)</b>	To prove how or why something is correct.
<b>Despite</b>	In spite of/ Even though.
<b>Consider (consideration)</b>	To think carefully.
<b>Apply (application)</b>	To put into action.
<b>Concise (concisely)</b>	To the point.
<b>Evaluate (evaluation)</b>	To judge the quality of something.
<b>Logic (logical, logically)</b>	A reasonable way of thinking about something.
<b>Infer (inference)</b>	To make a guess based on facts and observations.
<b>Locate (location)</b>	To find the position of something.
<b>Context (contextual)</b>	The situation in which something happens.
