Active School Meeting

The members of school council held a meeting with their class to ask for feedback on ways that we can make school more active. School councilors then shared feedback in our meeting – representing the voices of their peers.

Ideas

- Child led exercises in PE – pupils deliver the warmups in KS2
- Holiday clubs in each school holiday – available to all pupils
- Lessons outside – e.g. writing lessons
- Outdoor classrooms
- Mini sports days each term in sports day teams
- Daily Mile Maths – children to answer a math question on each lap
- Year 6 pupils act as sports coaches
- More drama in class
- Bench ball and basketball after school club
- KS2 Forest School with Mrs Allen
- Active sessions during the day – children acknowledged that we had already started this
- Dance when arrive to school – pupils acknowledged that Bright Start Club had restarted
- Active math: e.g. True/false math sessions where children have to run to true or false lines to answer etc.
- Corporal punishment – sit ups for talking in class when you shouldn't be – we discussed that this might not go down well :)
- Brain breaks
- Cross country club
- Zumba and Clubbercise club
- Teachers and TAs dancing with pupils like we did in lockdown
- Additional break time – discussed how this had started already
- Music outside at break times to dance to
- Always keep the L Factor performances
- Sponsored walk – told them that this has been scheduled from our first meeting for June
