



KEY STAGE 1 | RWM EXPECTED STANDARD

From a cohort of **29 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 1, **55.2%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths, a total of **16 pupils**.

17.2% achieved a greater depth in Reading, Writing & Maths, a total of **5 pupils**.






Your school's expected standard percentage in Reading, Writing & Maths has **decreased by 2.5%** from **57.7%** in 2018/19 to **55.2%** in 2021/22.

This is equivalent to approximately **1 fewer** pupil achieving the expected standard in 2021/22 compared to 2018/19.

Your school's average for the last 3 academic year(s) is **57.6%**.

COMPARISON | NATIONAL



55.2% achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths in your school, **1.8% higher than** the National average of **53.4%**.

This is equivalent to **1 more** pupil in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **1 time** in the last 3 academic year(s) for the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths has **improved by 10.9%**, from **-1.9%** in 2018/19 to **+9.0%** in 2021/22 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths has **decreased by 2.5%**, from **57.7%** in 2018/19 to **55.2%** in 2021/22, the National average **decreased by 11.5%**, from **64.9%** in 2018/19 to **53.4%** in 2021/22.
