Friday 30th August - Gobowen Pavilion and Playing Field

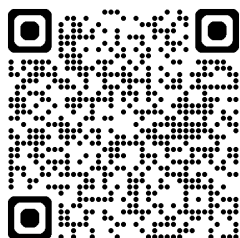
Three sessions per day are available:
